## 2011 RECYCLING BROCHURE

### GENERAL INFORMATION - 2011

You will notice that we have not included a calendar in this brochure.\* We have, however, created a chart for the individual routes. Using the chart, you will be able to determine when the DPW will begin a particular service. The routes have not been changed. They are based on your trash pick up.

- Route 1** - Garbage is picked up on Monday and Thursday
- Route 2** - Garbage is picked up on Tuesday and Friday and All Condominium Associations.
- Route 3** - Garbage is picked up on Wednesday and Saturday.

\*If you prefer the recycling schedule in calendar form, you will be receiving a copy of the Town Planner in the mail. The monthly calendar is available, in the Beavertown Journal, from the Borough Clerk's office. # DUAL STREAM RECYCLING picked up weekly

The Recycling Center will remain open and still accepts ALL Recyclable materials. The center accepts separated material and the DUAL-STREAM MATERIALS (YELLOW and BLUE CONTAINERS).



## MIXED PAPER

Items should be clean and flattened if possible. Smaller items can be placed in the yellow barrel or in a paper shopping bag or leaf paper bag. No food please. Yellow labels are available to place on your own containers.

## COMMINGLED CONTAINER

Items should be rinsed, flattened, if possible. Smaller items can be placed in the blue barrel or in a translucent or clear plastic bags. No food please. Blue labels are available to place on your own containers.

### ACCEPTABLE MATERIAL

- **ALUMINUM FOOD and BEVERAGE CONTAINERS:** Aluminum Soda & Beer Cans, Pet Food Cans, etc.
- **GLASS FOOD & BEVERAGE CONTAINERS:** Flint (clear), Amber (brown), Emerald (green)
- **FERROUS CANS:** Tin/Steel Soup, Food, Coffee Cans, etc.
- **PLASTICS:** Recycling emblems (1-7): SEE BELOW

## ITEMS ACCEPTED AT THE RECYCLING CENTER

	<b>ALKALINE BATTERIES:</b> such as AAA, AA, C, D and 9-volts can be and should be thrown out in Ordinary Garbage. <b>RECHARGEABLE,</b> Button Cell, Lithium and Lead-Acid batteries which are used for cars, boats and motorcycles can be brought to the Recycling Center and deposited in the designated area and containers. Drop boxes for rechargeables and cell phones are set up at various facilities.
	<b>MOTOR OIL:</b> Used Motor Oil should be in a clean container (Plastic or Metal) with a tight fitting lid. Residents are not permitted to bring more than 5 gallons at any one time. Oil, by D.E.P. regulations, must be deposited in the approved shed in the Recycling Center. <b>DO NOT EMPTY YOUR CONTAINERS INTO THE STORAGE DRUMS.</b>
	<b>TIRES:</b> The Recycling Center accepts, from residents, Auto Tires, Motorcycle Tires, Light Duty Truck Tires and Bicycle Tires. They must be removed from the rim and deposited in the trailer provided at the Recycling Center. No Truck Tires (over 16.5" rim) or Equipment Tires will be accepted. <b>TIRES ARE NOT COLLECTED FROM CURBSIDE.</b>
	<b>ALL SCRAP METAL:</b> Metal is recyclable and can be brought to the Borough Recycling Center. Examples include but are not limited to: pipe, metal railings, screens, gym sets, bicycles, file cabinets, tire rims, brass, aluminum doors and siding. Appliances (Washers, Dryers, Hot Water Heaters, Stoves & Refrigerators) will also be accepted at the Recycling Center Monday through Saturday. <b>NO PROPANE TANKS.</b>
	<b>ELECTRONICS RECYCLING:</b> Computers, Laptops, Monitors, Televisions, Desktop Printers, Printer/Fax/Copier/Scanner combinations, Computer Peripherals including keyboards, mice, hard drives and other devices, fax machines and DVD, VCR and other video players can all be deposited in the container at the recycling yard.

## ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE BOROUGH RECYCLING CENTER

	<b>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS:</b> Oil based paints, gasoline, thinner solvents, flammable liquids (except oil), transmission fluid, steering fluid, anti-freeze, pool chemicals, dark room materials, and small amounts of asbestos to Morris County's Hazardous Waste Collection Days. Spring and Fall dates to be announced. <b>- or -</b> Call Morris County at 973-829-8006 to make an appointment at their permanent facility. They are open most Fridays and Saturdays. <b>LATEX PAINT:</b> cans can be opened, filled and mixed with kitty litter or speed dri, allowed to dry and added to your regular trash - not recycling.
	<b>CONCRETE, ASPHALT, BRICKS, CINDER BLOCKS:</b> in any form will not be accepted at the Recycling Center. This includes, but is not limited to, sidewalk pieces, driveway pieces, bricks, and cinder blocks. Materials can be taken to: <b>Stone Industries,</b> Central Ave (continuation of Hamburg Tpk.) Haledon, NJ 973-595-6250
	<b>CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS &amp; ROOFING MATERIALS:</b> are not accepted at the Recycling Center. Residents and/or their contractors are responsible for the disposal of this material. Construction debris includes, but is not limited to: Construction Lumber, Roof Shingles (if separated) can be recycled, Tar Paper, Replacement Windows, Ceramic Tile, Sheetrock and Linoleum. This material can be taken to: Morris County Transfer Station, 1100 Edwards Rd. Parsippany, NJ. (Rt. 46 West to New Road. Cross over Rt 46 and follow New Rd. to Edwards Rd.) Phone # 973-808-9651. Mon-Fri 7:30 am - 3:00 pm & Sat. 7:30 am - 11 :00 am. Residents are required to bring a CHECK, Drivers License and one other form of ID.
	<b>MEDICAL WASTE:</b> medical wastes (syringes and lancets) are not accepted by the Borough or by Morris County. For information on recycling - call NJ Hospital Association at 609-273-4058.

## YARD WASTE POLICIES FOR LINCOLN PARK

	<b>GRASS &amp; VEGETATIVE WASTE:</b> The DPW will collect grass that is put out in either bio-degradable brown paper lawn & leaf bags or in garbage cans with tight fitting lids. Containers must be clearly marked "grass" (stickers available at Boro Hall). Grass put out in plastic bags will NOT be collected. Loose grass raked to curbside will NOT be collected. Residents may continue to bring their grass and yard waste to the Recycling Center. Landscapers may not deposit any form of yard waste at the Recycling Center. The grass schedule is included in this brochure. <b>ALTERNATIVES:</b> Residents are urged to consider either backyard composting or the "cut it & leave it" program as a means of disposing of their grass.
	<b>LEAVES:</b> The Borough will continue to pick up LEAVES during the FALL Months, only. The schedule is included in this brochure. <b>FOR COLLECTION: Leaves are to be raked loose to the curbside &amp; CANNOT be placed within 10 feet of catch basins/storm drains. Leaf piles should not contain Brush, Sticks or other Debris.</b> Loose leaves are only permitted at curbside during this scheduled period. Bagged leaves will not be collected & must be brought to the Recycling Center.
	<b>BRUSH &amp; BRANCHES:</b> must be cut into bundled or unbundles / loose and not to exceed six feet (6') in length or forty five (45) pounds. Oversized branches - larger than three inches (3") in diameter are not to be collected. These bundles will be placed near the curb line / edge of pavement. Brush is collected on the 2nd Thursday of APRIL, MAY, JUNE, SEPTEMBER, OCTOBER, and NOVEMBER. Brush can be taken to the recycling yard. No dump trucks or commercial vehicles. As an alternative, residents can take brush to Environmental Renewal, West Paterson, 973-890-8300, or Como & Sons, Towaco, 973-263-0440.
	<b>STUMPS:</b> can be taken to the The Stump Factory 973-584-5595.

## BULK - CURBSIDE AND RECYCLING CENTER DROP-OFF

	<b>BULK:</b> Bulk items will be picked up 4 times a year. Pick-up is determined by your route number. The schedule is included in this brochure. Items that will be picked up at curbside include: <b>Furniture</b> (chairs, sofas, dressers, etc.) <b>Appliances</b> (washer, dryer, refrigerator) <b>Lawn Mowers, Hot Water Heaters, Mattress &amp; Box Spring and Limited Wood Waste.</b> Items should not be put out more than 24 hours in advance of pick-up. Bulk items for the compactor can be dropped off at the Recycling Center every Friday or Saturday. <b>Items not collected:</b> auto parts, tires, construction debris (sheet rock, lumber), roofing materials, cement or asphalt, yard waste, hazardous material (gas, paint thinner, etc.) or household garbage.
