2010 N.J. DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

Dog Licenses are due for renewal by February 28, 2010, but cannot be renewed before January 1, 2010. Check your rabies information and neuter status. If there are changes, be sure to enclose the required copies of certificates. The fees are: \$18.00 for spayed/neutered or \$21.00 for all dogs that are not spayed/neutered. After March 1, 2010 a late fee of \$10.00 per dog will be imposed. **WE MUST HAVE PROOF OF RABIES GOOD THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2010 IN ORDER TO ISSUE A NEW LICENSE.**

Return this form with a check in the appropriate amount payable to the Borough of Lincoln Park. Your 2010 Tag License will then be mailed to you. Please notify the Health Department if you no longer own your dog. Please do not send cash through the mail.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET

Many Municipalities and public agencies must enact and enforce local pet-waste rules. An example is requiring pet owners or their keepers to pick up and properly dispose of pet waste dropped on public or other people's property.

Make sure you know your town's or Agency's requirements and comply with them. It's the law. And remember to: Use newspaper, bags or pooper-scoopers to pick up wastes. Dispose of the wrapped pet waste in the trash or unwrapped in a toilet. Never discard pet waste in a storm drain.
