ORDINANCE NO. 7-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30, PERSONNEL,
OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK**

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Park Employee Handbook contains various terms and conditions of employment as established by the Borough of Lincoln Park ("Borough") and authorized via resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Park Human Resources Policies and Procedures, which is promulgated by the Mayor, contains statutory provisions as well as those policies and procedures for employment with the Borough that are not contained within the Employee Handbook; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to amend Chapter 30, Personnel, of the Ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park so as to eliminate duplicate information that is contained in the Employee Handbook and the Human Resources Policies and Procedures and instead refer to said documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Chapter 30, Personnel, of the Ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park is hereby deleted in its entirety and shall read as follows:

30-1. PERSONNEL:

The terms and conditions of employment with the Borough of Lincoln Park are as specifically set forth in the Employee Handbook, which is adopted via resolution of the Borough Council, and as set forth in the Human Resources Policies and Procedures, which is promulgated by the Mayor, including amendments and revisions to the same.

SECTION TWO. All Ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION THREE. If any section, subsection, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of the Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
