ORDINANCE 17-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1,446, 2010
EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION OF THE
BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:48-2 permits a municipality to make and amend an Ordinance as it may deem necessary and proper for good government, order, and protection of persons and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park ("Borough") desires to amend Ordinance number 1,446, 2010 Employee Compensation Ordinance of the Borough of Lincoln Park in order to change the salary of the Police Chief;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:69A-180 for municipalities governed by the Faulkner Act form of Government, the salary, wages or other compensation paid to the Director of each Department within the municipality shall be fixed by the Council; and'

SECTION TWO: N.J.S.A. 40:69A-43A provides that the salaries of Officers that are required by law to be fixed by Ordinance shall be fixed by Ordinance; and

SECTION THREE: the Borough of Lincoln Park desires to set a range for the salary, wages and other compensation for those Officials and employees as set forth herein, which excludes only compensation for overtime and sell back of unused vacation days and sick days;

SECTION FOUR: the annual compensation range for the Police Chief within the Borough of Lincoln Park effective June 1, 2010 shall read as follows:

<u>Position Title</u>	<u>Minimum Compensation</u>	<u>Maximum Compensation</u>
Director/Chief Department of Police	\$40,000.00	\$149,250.00

SECTION FIVE: If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION SIX: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION SEVEN: This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage and publication as provided by law.
