

ORDINANCE NO. 6-12

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 212,
WATER, OF THE CODE BOOK OF THE BOROUGH OF LINCOLN PARK**

WHEREAS, Chapter 212-32 of the Code Book of the Borough of Lincoln Park ("Borough") currently provides a schedule which sets forth the water rates for all users; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to amend said schedule found at Chapter 212-36D of the Code Book of the Borough of Lincoln Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Lincoln Park, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 212-32D of the Code Book of the Borough of Lincoln Park is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. Charges of Rates for Water Consumption:

1. The following rates are hereby established:

CONSUMPTION CHARGES

QUARTERLY WATER RATES

0.75"	\$30.00	5,000	\$7.75	(5,001 to 100,000 gal)

1.50"	\$98.40	17,700	\$7.75	(17,701 to 100,000 gal)

4.00"	\$390.00	70,000	\$7.75	(70,001 to 100,000 gal)
8.00"	\$864.00	0	\$7.75	(100,001 gal)

All gallonage in excess of 100,000 gallons shall be billed at \$7.75 per 1,000 gallons.

User application procedures and charges for use outside the Borough:

Administrative and maintenance fixed at 10% of the fee which relates to water consumption and which will be determined by using the rates established by Borough Ordinance.

2. There shall be a minimum rate of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per quarter for all un-metered water customers.

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Borough of Lincoln Park which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect starting with the quarterly water bill period of April 1, 2012 through June 30, 2012.
