ARE YOU...

- bitten mainly in the daytime?
- bitten mostly in shaded areas of your property?
- often bitten on the feet, ankles, or lower legs?
- bitten by small (about ¼") black mosquitoes with ***bright white stripes*** on the legs, back and head?

If you answered yes to most of these questions you probably have Asian tiger mosquitoes in your neighborhood.

Dump standing water to destroy mosquito habitat



Check for containers like:

- Old tires
- Buckets
- Kiddie Pools
- Toys
- Watering Cans
- Pet Dishes
- Bird Baths
- Plastic Tarps
- Flower Pots
