DOG LICENSE RENEWAL

Your current Dog License expires December 31st. Enclosed is a copy of **last year's** dog license paperwork. Review the enclosed form **with last year's information**, note any changes (**age will update when renewed**) and return with all required copies of paperwork and payment (you can use one check for multiple dogs) to: Borough of Lincoln Park, Attn: Dog Licensing, 34 Chapel Hill Road, Lincoln Park, NJ 07035
Make checks/money orders payable to the Borough of Lincoln Park. We do not accept credit cards. Do not send cash through the mail.

PROOF OF RABIES GOOD THROUGH OCTOBER 31ST OF THE LICENSING YEAR MUST BE SUBMITTED IN ORDER FOR A LICENSE TO BE ISSUED.

(You only need to send in copies of **updated/new** rabies vaccinations – do not send in originals)

The fee per dog is \$20.00 or \$23.00 if not spayed or neutered.

Payments are due by January 31st, but not before January 2nd.

STARTING FEBRUARY 1st A LATE FEE OF \$15.00 PER DOG WILL BE IMPOSED.

****You must notify the health dept. if you no longer have your dog so we can update our records and to avoid receiving a summons for not renewing your dog license.****

You do not need to fill out a new application for previously licensed dogs.



From The NJ Department of Health and Municipal Governments to Distribute Animal Cruelty Materials to Each Person Licensing a Dog
(Date of Notice: October 12, 2018)

This notice is being distributed to each person obtaining an annual dog license and will be posted on the Municipal Website. Pursuant to the provisions of P.L. 2017, CHAPTER 189 b. The New Jersey Department of Health (NJDOH) has provided the following information:

- 4:22-17 Cruelty; certain acts, crime; degrees
- 4:22-26 Penalties for various acts constituting cruelty
- Guide to Prevention of Animal Cruelty Laws 2018
