CAMP INFORMATION

- ◆ **ABSENCES:** If a camper will be absent, please e-mail us at lpsummercamp@bolp.org or call/text the camp director at 973-525-6646.
- ◆ **DROP-OFF / PICK-UP:** Camp directors and counselors will be on site for 8:30am drop-off, NO EARLY DROP OFFS ARE PERMITTED. NON-EMERGENCY late pick-ups charged \$5 per 1/2 hour.
- ◆ **CONTACTS:** Please supply accurate contact information. Emergency contact should be someone who is nearby and available during camp hours.
- ◆ **ILLNESS:** If your camper has a temperature, is sick or shows any symptoms or other signs of illness, they should stay home. If the directors feel your child is showing any symptoms, you or your emergency contact will be called to pick up your camper.
- ◆ **LAKE DAYS** are scheduled for TUESDAYS & THURSDAYS, weather permitting. Drop-off and pick-up are at the Community Lake, regular camp times. SIGNED SWIM PERMISSION IS MANDATORY - lifeguards will be on-duty and ALL campers will be swim tested, but they must have a written permission slip to swim. Please send your child dressed in their swimsuit, also send your camper with a towel. Kindly apply sunscreen before they arrive at camp. Flip-flops may be worn on Lake Days.
- ◆ **MEDICAL:**
 - ***Medical Records:** Current immunization records and a completed medical health history are required for each camper. No child is permitted to attend camp without these documents.
 - ***Medications:** Medications, (prescribed and/or over-the-counter) are not permitted at camp.
 - ***Epi-Pens:** are permitted if submitted to Director in original box with prescription label.
 - ***Injuries at Camp:** Basic care will be administered at camp for all minor incidents. Should an injury require emergency medical treatments, we will notify the parent or emergency contact.
 - ***Other:** Please address all conditions or other health concerns with the camp directors.
- ◆ **SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS:** Please contact the camp directors to discuss any special concerns and/or accommodations that will enhance your child's camp experience. Please e-mail us or speak with one of the camp directors, all information is confidential.
- **PERSONAL ITEMS:** The Borough of Lincoln Park Summer Camp is not responsible for any personal items that are lost, stolen or broken at camp, at the LPCL or while on trips.
- **REFUNDS:** Refunds are not offered for missed days, weeks or trips. Refunds are only offered if the Borough is forced to cancel camp. Week transfers are permitted with adequate notice.
- ◆ **SHIRTS:** Campers will receive ONE (1) camp shirt, sizes not guaranteed on registrations after June 1.
- ◆ **SHOES:** Sneakers are **MANDATORY** for camp days. Flip Flops are permitted on **LAKE DAYS** only.
- ◆ **SNACKS & DRINKS:** **Please send your camper with a snack and water bottle each day.** Ice-pops are distributed at the end of each day, time permitting.
- ◆ **SUNSCREEN:** Campers spend the majority of the day outdoors so sunscreen should be applied before camp, staff is not permitted to apply sunscreen, so we suggest packing SPRAY sunscreen for additional application during the day. Children must wear appropriate clothing and footwear. Sandals and flip flops are not permitted on regular camp days.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Encourage your camper to join the **FOUR-HOUR ELECTRONIC-FREE CHALLENGE** by leaving their cell phones and other electronic devices at home. These devices can be damaged, misplaced, stolen or lost. Their use potentially disrupts camp activities. Improper use of these devices combined with internet capability creates personal privacy and liability issues for parents and campers. We want our campers to “look up” from their screens and allow camp to be a place for fun, new experiences and new friends. Children need to know who they can turn to, (other than a parent), with a problem or when they feel unsafe, which will be reinforced at camp. All camp directors and camp counselors have phones and will be willing to help a child call their parents, if necessary.
