NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT

LPCL NON-MOTORIZED WATERCRAFT RULES

- Use of non-motorized watercrafts are permitted from dawn to dusk from April 1—October 31.
- Use is limited to Lincoln Park residents and their guests only.
- Non-motorized watercrafts are defined as canoes (under 18 feet), kayaks (under 14 feet) and rowboats (under 18 feet), owned and operated by residents of the Borough of Lincoln Park.
- Each watercraft will be registered annually with the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation through the Clerk’s Office or the Recreation Department.
- Each watercraft will have a separate registration AND the vehicle transporting said watercraft will have a parking permit.
- Hobby or toy-sized watercrafts are excluded and prohibited from use at the LPCL. Use of inflatable rafts or other watercrafts are prohibited.
- Use of registered watercrafts is limited to designated areas only in the LPCL and operation is prohibited within 25 feet of the municipal swim lanes, docks or other lake recreation equipment areas.
- Watercrafts shall only be launched from the designated area at the entrance to the Lake and shall not be docked at any other location.
- Lifejackets must meet the US Coast Guard standards and must be worn by everyone using the non-motorized craft. Lifejackets to be supplied by boat owner...LP life vests are not for rent or “on-loan” use.
- All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18.
 - *Food, beverages, tobacco and all “e-cigarette”/vaping products use are prohibited on any watercraft*
- Swimming from registered watercraft is prohibited.
- The Superintendent of Parks and Recreation has the authority to revoke a watercraft registration for any violations of the above rules, violation of the Watercraft Ordinance or violation of 154-28 of the LP Code Book.
- The Superintendent of Parks and Recreation will have the authority to close the Lake to all non-motorized watercrafts during special events or other reasons that effect the safety and welfare of the Lake members, Lake Staff and Borough residents. In the absence of the Superintendent of Parks and Recreation, The Lake Director shall have the same authority.
- Registration Fee is \$25 per watercraft per season. There are not provisions for pro-rating the fee on a daily, weekly or monthly basis.
